

#### **CURRENCY:**

The shilling appreciated against the dollar today and is trading at **102.95** from **102.92** recorded last Friday. This was majorly attributed to an decrease in demand for the dollar from the importers in the country.

#### MONEY MARKET:

The interbank rate increased marginally to **2.44%** from **2.38%** recorded on Friday. This indicates that liquidity is still relatively high in the market..

#### **EQUITIES:**

The NSE equity turnover was up **60.63%** to stand at **KES 527Mn** from **KES 207Mn** recorded yesterday. The top traders today were Cooperative Bank, Safaricom and Equity Bank. The counters recorded a turnover of **KES 112Mn**, **KES 77Mn** and **KES 4Mn** respectively.

Foreigners were net sellers on the Safaricom and EABL counters.


